

10 A I was on the phone with her and then when
11 she went out that day I was still texting her the whole
12 night.

13 Q Okay. I want to show you a photograph,
14 ma'am. Showing you State's Proposed Exhibit 35, do you
15 recognize that person?

16 A Yes.

17 Q Who is that?

18 A That's my sister. That's Lesly Palacio.

19 Q Do you know this man next to her?

20 A Yes.

21 Q Who is that?

22 A Erick Rangel.

23 Q To be fair, you don't know when this was
24 taken, do you?

25 A When? It could be that night that she went

18 happened text?

19 A It should be like a minute when she sent me

21 Q Okay. That's okay. Within a minute you
22 would say?

23 A Yeah.

24 Q And then you never heard back from her?

13:23:07 25 A Yeah, I never heard back.

13:23:09 1 Q Okay. Where did Lesly live at the time?

2 A She lived with my parents with me.

3 Q Okay.

4 A Yeah.

13:23:21 5 Q Did she return home that morning?

6 A No.

7 Q Did that cause you some concern?

8 A Yes.

9 Q Okay. What did you do once you realized
13:23:30 10 she didn't return home?

11 A Well, I kept like trying to call her and
12 then her phone went straight to voice mail. So I went
13 home and I told my mom because she asked for her and
14 then after that like we tried to get in contact with his
13:23:48 15 family.

16 Q His being?

17 A Erick Rangel.

18 Q Okay. How did you know Mr. Rangel?

19 A Because he was like a family friend from
13:23:59 20 like, you know, we've been known him for like ten years
21 and stuff like that, uh-huh.

22 Q Okay. At some point that next day did you
23 file a missing persons report?

24 A Yeah, it was that weekend. I think it was
13:24:16 25 on August 30th because they told us to wait like --

13:24:20 1 Q Okay. So is it on the 29th that you
2 communicate with Erick's family?

3 A Yeah.

13:24:29 4 Q Okay. Did you physically go over to their
5 home?

6 A No, I contacted his sister.

7 Q Okay. I don't want to hear anything about
8 that communication.

9 A Okay.

13:24:36 10 Q Did you and your family go to the home of
11 the Rangels at some point?

12 A Yes.

13 Q Was that on the 29th?

14 A Yes.

13:24:43 15 Q What did you observe when you got there?

16 A When we first got there we were trying to
17 like, you know, we were knocking and then trying to --
18 and no one was answering. And then we came back like an
19 hour later and then we just saw a vehicle and then the
13:25:06 20 mom and then the two daughters and they were like
21 putting furniture in the truck.

22 Q Okay. Did you see items that appeared to
23 be cleaning supplies or cleaning --

13:25:23 24 A Yeah, they were wearing -- one of them was
25 wearing gloves.

13:25:24 1 Q What type of gloves?
2 A Just like cleaning gloves or like, you
3 know --
4 Q Are you talking about like rubber gloves?
13:25:30 5 A Yeah, like rubber gloves.
6 Q Okay. Do you know what time on the 29th
7 this was?
8 A It had to be like around 11:00 in the
9 morning.
13:25:39 10 Q Okay. Did you see Mr. Rangel?
11 A No.
12 Q Do you know who Mr. Rangel's father is? Do
13 you know his name?
14 A Jose.
13:25:50 15 Q Did you see him there at the home when you
16 were there?
17 A No.
18 Q Okay. You just saw you said the mom and
19 sisters. I'm just trying to figure out who these people
13:25:59 20 are.
21 A Yes.
22 Q Is that the mom of Erick Rangel?
23 A Yes.
24 Q And the sisters of Erick Rangel?
13:26:04 25 A Yes.

13:26:04 1 Q Ultimately you said you initiated a missing
2 persons report?

3 A Uh-huh.

4 Q Is that a yes?

13:26:12 5 A Yes.

6 Q And were you then contacted by some
7 homicide detectives?

8 A Yes.

9 Q And eventually did you provide that
13:26:19 10 information about the text messages you were exchanging
11 with your sister?

12 A Yes.

13 MR. GIORDANI: I have no further questions
14 for this witness at this time. Do any of the Grand
13:26:31 15 Jurors have questions? Seeing no hands.

12 BY MR. GIORDANI:

13 Q Sir, do you know a person by the name of
14 Erick Rangel?

13:29:35 15 A Yes, I do.

16 Q And how long have you known Erick Rangel
17 approximately?

18 A Approximately about five, six years.

13:29:49 19 Q Would you consider yourself to have been
20 friends for that time period?

21 A About so, yes.

22 Q Okay. Did Erick Rangel contact you at the
23 very end of August, 2020?

24 A Yes, he did.

13:30:05 25 Q Do you recall how he contacted you?

13:30:07 1 A Telephone call.

2 Q And what was your phone number at that
3 time?

4 A (213) 810-7103.

13:30:20 5 Q And when he contacted you, did his phone
6 number pop up in your phone or did his name pop up or do
7 you recall?

8 A Not that I recall.

9 Q Okay. Do you remember the day of the week
13:30:36 10 it was when he contacted you?

11 A It was a Saturday.

12 Q Okay. What time of day on that Saturday if
13 you recall?

14 A Morning hours, roughly between maybe 8:00
13:30:46 15 a.m. or so.

16 Q And when he contacted you did you answer?

17 A Yes, I did.

18 Q When you answered did you recognize the
19 voice of the person on the line?

13:30:58 20 A I did but wasn't quite sure.

21 Q Okay. And what did you do when you
22 answered?

23 A I asked who it was and he stated it was
24 Erick.

13:31:07 25 Q Okay. Did you then recognize it as Erick?

13:31:10

1 A Yes, I did.

2 Q What did Erick say when he contacted you?

3 A When he contacted me he asked me if he
4 could, if I could help him out. He had said do you

13:31:19

5 remember that favor that I asked you for, he goes can
6 you help me out, so I asked him a few times --

7 Q Let me stop you for a moment because the
8 Grand Jury's hearing all this for the first time, okay?

9 A Sure.

13:31:30

10 Q What do you mean he said do you remember
11 that favor I asked you about, what's the context there?

12 A The story behind that?

13 Q Yeah.

14 A Maybe about, almost about a month, not too

13:31:45

15 sure quite exactly when, but when I was in there eating
16 on my lunch break, him and his brother had joined me
17 because they seen me in the restaurant eating. He asked
18 me, he said hey, he was pretty drunk, he asked me, he
19 said hey, if I ever need a favor from you can you do it

13:32:02

20 for me.

21 Q Okay. And let me stop you there. This was
22 months prior, right?

23 A Approximately, yes.

24 Q Okay. Or at the very least several weeks?

13:32:11

25 A To the best of my knowledge, yes.

13:32:13 1 Q Okay. So this conversation you're
2 describing now has absolutely nothing to do with the
3 disappearance or murder of Lesly Palacio, can we agree
4 there?

13:32:24 5 A Yes, we can agree there.

6 Q Okay. So he calls you basically out of the
7 blue late August and asked you about this favor; is that
8 right?

9 A Correct.

13:32:31 10 Q Okay. Now that it's in context, can you go
11 on and explain the rest of the conversation?

12 A Sure. So he asked, he said so can you do
13 me that favor. So I said okay, what's up, what do you
14 need. So he had stated that he needed me to bring him
13:32:51 15 gas. So I kept asking, well, why do you need gas. I
16 thought that it was kind of odd that he wanted me to
17 bring him gasoline. He said that he didn't want to be
18 seen on camera. He said he needed me to bring him the
19 gasoline. So I kept poking around a little bit to ask
13:33:11 20 why because I thought it was kind of weird.

21 Q Let me stop you. Did he say where he was?

22 A Yes, after about a couple more times asking
23 he stated he was in Utah.

24 Q Okay. Go on.

13:33:26 25 A So then at that point he replied to me, he

13:33:30 1 goes I need the gasoline, he said I killed a bitch.

2 Q I killed a bitch?

3 A Yes. And then I -- he was so calm about it
4 to the point where I just, I didn't believe it, so at

13:33:43 5 that point I'm just like are you serious, I'm like, no,

6 you're messing with me. He goes no, I'm for real, he

7 goes I killed a bitch. And then he said it again one

8 more time and then he said I'm serious, she's dead in

9 the back seat of my car right now.

13:33:59 10 Q Did he say car?

11 A Truck.

12 Q Your mask is killing me here. Did you say
13 car or truck, I'm sorry?

14 A Let me rephrase that. He did say she is

13:34:08 15 dead in the back seat of my truck.

16 Q Okay. Thank you, sir. When he said I
17 killed a bitch several times, did you respond or did you
18 question him further or how did that go?

19 A At first I took a pause, I kind of

13:34:26 20 questioned him a little further because I fully didn't

21 believe it at the time, especially because of just how

22 calm he was I figured, no, he can't be serious. So I

23 asked him and he kept saying I'm serious. So at that

24 point I pretty much just told him, I said, you know, I

13:34:45 25 said hey, I can't do you that favor, you know, I've got

13:34:49 1 to go pick up my daughter in the morning, made up an
2 excuse to kind of get him to back off a little bit
3 because he was pretty persistent in asking. Then he
4 goes, for the most part he goes -- I said why would you
13:35:04 5 call me and say this. He goes, well, he goes it's a
6 burner phone. And then that's when I stated you fucked
7 up by telling me.

8 Q Okay. And what do you know a burner phone
9 to mean?

13:35:18 10 A A burner phone, I mean, I'm not really too
11 sure what it was. I'm assuming it's obviously a ghost
12 phone or something.

13 Q Okay. So you were saying to him why did
14 you call me and he says it's a burner phone?

13:35:37 15 A Correct.

16 Q Okay. And when you made your excuse as to
17 why you couldn't help him, did that essentially
18 terminate the conversation?

19 A It terminated it right then and there. He
13:35:51 20 just said okay. And then after I told him that he
21 fucked up by calling me he just says all right then and
22 then he hung up on me.

23 Q Did you know Mr. Rangel to drive a
24 particular vehicle?

13:36:02 25 A A white truck, Ford F-150 I believe it is.

13:36:07 1 Q Okay. All right. Thank you, sir.

2 And I have no further questions for this
3 witness. Do any of the Grand Jurors have questions?
4 There's one.

13:36:30 5 BY A JUROR:

6 Q When he asked you weeks before or months
7 before if you would do him a favor, did he tell you what
8 the favor was going to be?

9 A No, ma'am, he did not. All he said was if
13:36:46 10 I ever need a favor from you would you do it for me,

14 Q What do you do for a living, sir?

13:39:46 15 A I'm a detective with the Las Vegas

16 Metropolitan Police Department.

17 Q And what unit are you currently assigned?

18 A Homicide section.

19 Q How long have you been in the homicide

13:39:54 20 section?

21 A Four and a half years.

22 Q What did you do before homicide?

23 A I was a narcotics detective for 14 and a
24 half years and five years in patrol.

13:40:02 25 Q I want to bring your attention to late

13:40:04 1 August of last year. At some point in time in late
2 August or very early September, did you become aware of
3 a missing persons report regarding Lesly Palacio?

4 A Yes, I did.

13:40:17 5 Q Do you recall what date that first came to
6 your attention?

7 A The first of September last year, 2020.

8 Q Prior to it coming to your attention, was
9 someone else in the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police
13:40:28 10 Department handling that missing persons case?

11 A Yes, the detectives in the missing persons
12 section originally got the case on the 30th of August.

13 Q Did you, as a homicide detective, develop
14 or learn that there may be other missing person cases
13:40:47 15 related to Lesly Palacio's missing persons case?

16 A Yes, the missing persons people received a
17 missing persons report from the family of Erick and Jose
18 Rangel listing them as missing and they put two and two
19 together that the two were related and came to us.

13:41:07 20 Q Okay. So the missing persons detective put
21 those together and brought it to your attention?

22 A Correct.

23 Q And to be clear, those reports, those three
24 different missing persons reports were
13:41:17 25 August 30th/August 31st of 2020?

13:41:21 1 A Correct, Palacio was the 30th and the
2 Rangels was the 31st.

3 Q When you received the case, what was your
4 first kind of assignment or where did you go? What did
13:41:33 5 you do first?

6 A When I first -- they brought the case to me
7 and they briefed me on their findings. They had located
8 surveillance video of Erick Rangel and Lesly Palacio
9 from the early morning hours of August 30th, and based
13:41:50 10 on their investigation of the facts from interviewing
11 both family members they decided that this was extremely
12 suspicious and that she was possibly dead. They briefed
13 me on their investigation. I then drafted search
14 warrants for the Rangles' house on Tipper Avenue and for

4 Q Are you the lead case agent?

13:42:53 5 A Yes.

6 Q Okay. I want to show you now State's 35
7 through 43. If you could just thumb through those real
8 briefly and I'm going to ask you, do you recognize all
9 of those as still images from surveillance footage the
13:43:14 10 night of the 28th of August through the early morning
11 hours of the 29th of August?

12 A Yes. The first four are from the Bourbon
13 Street Casino at Charleston and Nellis, and the second
14 group is from the Longhorn Casino on Boulder Highway and
13:43:33 15 Harmon.

16 Q Okay. And do those appear to be fair and
17 accurate depictions and still photos taken from the
18 actual video surveillance associated with those
19 establishments?

13:43:45 20 A Yes.

21 Q I'm going to start with State's 35. Did
22 you say that's Bourbon Street?

23 A Yes, that was from August 30th at
24 approximately 4:30 a.m. That's Mr. Rangel and Miss

13:44:03 25 Palacio entering the Bourbon Street Casino.

13:44:07 1 Q State's 36, is that inside the Bourbon
2 Street?

3 A Yes, that's after they were buzzed in.

13:44:18 4 Q State's 37, is that them in the bottom left
5 portion of the screen?

6 A Yes, that's them having tequila shots and
7 beers.

8 Q Did you observe them having several drinks
9 throughout the early morning hours?

13:44:29 10 A Yes, they had multiple drinks there.

11 Q Including Lesly?

12 A Yes, including Lesly.

13 Q State's 38, what is that?

13:44:43 14 A That's at approximately 5:45 a.m., the two
15 of them leaving. They are walking towards Erick
16 Rangel's white Ford F-150.

17 Q And the Ford F-150 is in the top right area
18 of the screen?

19 A Yes.

13:44:54 20 Q Now I'm showing you State's 39, what are we
21 looking at in this one?

22 A That is video from the Longhorn Casino.
23 That was approximately midnight 20 a.m. on the 30th.
24 That's them arriving and they're walking from Mr.

13:45:11 25 Rangel's white Ford F-150.

13:45:15 1 Q State's 40, is this them entering the
2 establishment?

3 A Yes, that's the two of them up there by the
4 time stamp walking into the diner area.

13:45:25 5 Q And that is the Longhorn, correct?

6 A The Longhorn, yes.

7 Q Did they also have alcoholic beverages at
8 this establishment?

9 A Yes, they had numerous beverages while
13:45:35 10 eating.

11 Q Oh, so they ate as well?

12 A Yes, they were in the diner until about
13 1:50.

14 Q 1:50?

13:45:44 15 A I believe it was 1:50.

16 Q Okay. State's 41, is that that same diner
17 you just described?

18 A Yes, that's them going in.

19 Q Okay. State's 42?

13:45:56 20 A That is them leaving.

21 Q Okay. And there's a time stamp on this, it
22 says 1:56. Based upon your investigation was that
23 accurate?

24 A Yes.

13:46:08 25 Q And then State's 43, is that them leaving

13:46:11 1 in the parking lot area?

2 A Correct, they walked to his truck, get in
3 and the truck drives off.

13:46:23 4 Q So fair to say that the Longhorn stop was
5 before the Bourbon Street stop?

6 A Yes, the Bourbon -- they left the Longhorn
7 approximately 1:00, there was additional video found at
8 a Putter's bar on Charleston and Sloan. They went
9 there, arrived there approximately 2:15 and had drinks

13:46:39 10 there. It's not clear on the video at what time they
11 left but then they resurfaced at the Bourbon Street at
12 approximately 4:30.

13 Q Understood. So fair to say they're
14 drinking relatively heavily throughout the evening and
13:46:53 15 early morning hours?

16 A Correct.

17 Q And I'm showing you again State's 35. Can
18 you see the pattern on Lesly's shirt in this still
19 photograph?

13:47:03 20 A Yes, it's a horizontal striped black and
21 white type pattern.

22 Q And for the record she's wearing blue
23 jeans?

24 A Correct.

13:47:19 25 Q You stated that several people were

13:47:21 1 interviewed and search warrants were authored. Is there
2 another detective here today who can talk about the
3 search warrant executed at the Rangel residence?

13:47:36 4 A Yes. The way it broke out for manpower, we
5 served two warrants at once. I and my co-case took the
6 Rangel daughter's apartment because the family was there
7 that needed interviewed. Detective Mitch Dosch handled
8 the crime scene at Tipper, the Rangel residence.

13:47:55 9 Q Okay. Did you, as the lead case detective,
10 become aware of surveillance video that was located in
11 the area of the Tipper residence?

12 A Yes.

13 Q And did you impound that video?

14 A Yes.

13:48:05 15 Q And then was that provided to our office
16 during the course of this prosecution?

17 A Yes.

18 Q I'm going to show you -- anyone have the
19 remote here? Thank you, sir.

13:48:29 20 Showing you now State's Proposed Exhibit 3,
21 just for authentication purposes, does this show five
22 different, essentially five clips of video surveillance?

23 A Yes.

13:48:44 24 Q I'm going to open the first clip and pause
25 it and then have you look at this for a moment. Do you

13:48:49 1 recognize this, sir?

2 A Yes.

3 Q And for the Grand Jury's purposes, where is
4 the Tipper residence located in this frame?

13:49:04 5 A By the red zone you can see a car in the
6 driveway. Would you like me to come up and show you?

7 Q Top far right?

8 A Yes.

9 Q Okay. Is it the black or dark car --

13:49:15 10 A Yes.

11 Q -- you're referring to?

12 A Yes.

13 Q Okay. Now, is this the home that you
14 executed a search warrant on and identified as Erick

13:49:23 15 Rangel's home with his family?

16 A Yes, 5285 Tipper.

17 Q And just for identification purposes, this
18 first chapter I've opened has a date and time stamp of
19 August 29th, 2020, starting at 6:04 a.m., this

13:49:38 20 particular chapter; is that right?

21 A Correct.

22 Q And was this relevant, this time period
23 relevant to you for any purpose?

24 A Yes, it's just before the video picks up

13:49:50 25 Rangel's truck arriving home and escorting Lesly into

13:49:56 1 his house.

2 Q Okay. Now, to be fair, you've never met
3 Mr. Rangel, correct?

4 A No.

13:50:02 5 Q So when you say it's him that's walking in
6 with Miss Palacio, you're inferring that?

7 A At the time I was inferring it but
8 subsequently his father identified him.

9 Q Okay, understood.

13:50:16 10 And I'm going to have the Grand Jury
11 disregard that last statement. Can everyone understand?
12 Does everyone understand my advisement and will follow
13 that advisement? It looks like everyone's nodding their
14 heads yes.

13:50:28 15 I'm going to go ahead and play this,
16 Detective, like I said starting at 6:04 a.m.

17 (Video playing.)

18 Q I'm going to speed this up a bit and then
19 pause it when we get to 6:04:23. What are we looking at
13:50:56 20 there?

21 (Video playing.)

22 A That is Mr. Rangel's pick-up truck arriving
23 home.

13:51:29 24 Q Does it appear that a male figure got out
25 of the driver's seat of the truck?

13:51:31 1 A Yes.

2 Q And then went around to the passenger side
3 of the truck?

4 A Correct.

13:52:08 5 Q What are we seeing here at about 6:05:32?

6 A A male with clothing consistent to what he
7 was wearing in the surveillance video is assisting what
8 appears to be an intoxicated female wearing clothing
9 consistent with Lesly's clothing in the video into his
10 residence.

13:52:29 11 Q Thank you. Just for the record, the white
12 F-150 truck remains parked in front of the residence in
13 the red zone on the street, correct?

14 A Correct.

13:52:40 15 Q Closing out of the first chapter. Now
16 jumping to the second chapter.

17 (Video playing.)

18 Q For authentication purposes, does this
19 appear to be the same camera but now we're looking at
13:52:54 20 August 29th at 6:48 a.m.?

21 A August 30th. Does the time stamp on that
22 say the 29th?

23 Q Yes, sir.

13:53:09 24 A Okay. It was incorrect by a day but it was
25 actually August 30th.

13:53:17 1 Q Would looking at your report refresh your
2 recollection as to the date? So does it appear to you
3 that the date may be off by a little bit on the video?

4 A Yes.

13:54:02 5 Q Okay. While that plays I'm going to refer
6 you to your report again. What are we looking at here
7 at 6:50:24?

8 A I missed that.

9 Q Does the vehicle drive away?

13:55:19 10 A Okay, that was -- the vehicle drove away,
11 yes.

12 Q I'm going to go to chapter three on this
13 exhibit disc. Pausing it once again. Is this the same
14 camera angle at 7:09 a.m.?

13:55:48 15 (Video playing.)

16 A Yes. And that is the vehicle coming back
17 and the male getting out of the driver's side.

18 Q Okay. And just for clarification in the
19 record, the last chapter I showed you, chapter two, that
13:56:17 20 showed the vehicle leaving. Did it appear to be just
21 the male figure get into that vehicle and leave?

22 A Yes. At one point the male threw something
23 into the driver's seat or into the vehicle and left for
24 approximately 15 minutes.

13:56:34 25 Q You couldn't see what that something was?

13:56:35 1 Was it a small item?

2 A It was, yeah, it was bigger than your hand
3 but you can't tell from that video what it was.

13:56:54 4 Q Okay. Now going to the fourth chapter or
5 segment of this exhibit disc, for the record same
6 camera?

7 A Yes.

8 Q Now we're looking at 7:24:33?

9 A Correct.

13:57:00 10 (Video playing.)

11 Q What are we looking at there?

12 A The male with the clothing consistent to
13 Erick's is out the passenger door, front passenger door
14 of his truck, and it appeared to me to be dragging a
13:57:19 15 body out.

16 Q Okay. Now, did a second male just enter
17 the frame?

18 A Yes, that second male in white was
19 assisting the other male drag the body out and place it
13:57:34 20 in the front passenger compartment.

21 Q Okay. At 7:26 approximately 16, do you see
22 what appears to be a body being dragged by those two
23 males?

24 A Yes.

13:59:49 25 Q 7:27:24, does the truck leave?

13:59:54 1 A Yes, it was proceeded by the white male
2 having to force the door closed.

3 Q Okay. And you later identified that
4 individual as Jose Rangel?

14:00:08 5 A Yes.

6 Q Is that the father of Erick Rangel?

7 A Yes.

8 Q And he remains at this home when the truck
9 leaves in that frame; is that right?

14:00:15 10 A Correct.

11 Q I'm going to show you the fifth and final
12 chapter on this exhibit. For authentication, same
13 camera we're looking at?

14 A Correct.

14:00:27 15 Q Now we're looking at 7:29:23 and rolling.

16 (Video playing.)

17 Q What are we looking at at 7:29?

18 A That is Jose Rangel comes away from the
19 doorway of the residence and picks up a hose and starts
14:00:53 20 spraying water on that little patch of rocks and grass
21 and on the driveway.

22 Q Is that the area where it appeared to you
23 the body had been dragged?

24 A Yes.

14:01:04 25 Q Okay. So, Detective, after having received

14:02:30 1 and reviewed the various surveillance footage that
2 you've now testified to, did you issue a warrant for the
3 arrest of Erick and Jose Rangel?

4 A Yes, I did.

14:02:49 5 Q At some point after that warrant was
6 issued, sir, was there a body located that was
7 apparently consistent with that of Lesly Palacio?

8 A Yes.

9 Q Do you remember when that was?

14:03:03 10 A The body was located on the 9th of
11 September.

12 Q Of 2020?

13 A 2020, yes.

14:03:14 14 Q And did you go out to that particular scene
15 as well?

16 A Yes, I did.

17 Q I'm going to show you State's 44 through
18 50. If you could look through those and tell me if you
19 recognize them.

14:03:35 20 A Yes, I do.

21 Q What do those appear to be generally?

22 A These are pictures of Lesly Palacio's body
23 in the desert.

24 Q Where was her body located?

14:03:52 25 A It was a few miles east of I-15 on the

14:03:57 1 Valley of Fire highway approximately 2500 feet on the
2 dirt road off of that in the middle of a wash.

3 Q Is it still within Clark County, Nevada?

4 A Yes.

14:04:07 5 Q And the Rangel residence or the Tipper
6 Avenue residence, that's within Clark County, Nevada?

7 A Yes.

8 Q Showing you State's 44, just generally
9 describe what we're looking at here.

14:04:25 10 A If you look to the lower left of the bush
11 you'll see the body. It's black from being out in the
12 desert and decomposing. It's been concealed behind a
13 bush. You couldn't see that from the road, the way it's
14 deposited there.

14:04:44 15 Q State's 45, is that a close-up of the body?

16 A Yes, it is.

17 Q And can you see anything of note?

18 A Yes, she's wearing the same horizontal
19 striped top that Lesly was seen in video wearing.

14:04:59 20 Q What color is the hair of the body hair?

21 A It's blond.

22 Q I want to show you State's 46. Was there
23 anything of note in State's 46?

24 A Yes, the body had no pants and it wasn't

14:05:23 25 readily apparent at the scene but at the subsequent

14:05:26 1 autopsy the underwear had been put on improperly. The
2 thong part that goes between the legs and the crotch is
3 actually around the waist as if somebody had placed them
4 on her that wasn't familiar with women's underwear.

14:05:46 5 Q And just for the record here in this
6 particular exhibit you can see those panties you just
7 described?

8 A Yes.

14:06:00 9 Q No part of that goes through her backside
10 at all?

11 A No, they went through but they were, as if
12 you put a leg -- a leg was through the waist hole and
13 the waist was in a leg hole.

14:06:12 14 Q Understood. Thank you. Showing you
15 State's 47, can you describe kind of what we're looking
16 at in this exhibit?

17 A That's the body again. She's black from
18 decomposition.

14:06:30 19 Q At the time in September of 2020, do you
20 know the weather generally?

21 A Yes, it was very hot.

22 Q Okay. And fair to say that her body is
23 significantly decomped and almost mummified to some
24 extent?

14:06:43 25 A Yes, and insect activity as well.

14:06:48 1 Q State's 48, what are we looking at here?

2 A Those are a pair of women's jeans
3 consistent with what she was wearing in the video that
4 were in a bush several feet away.

14:07:00 5 Q Did you notice anything else in the area of
6 the scene?

7 A Yeah, we were able to locate, we located
8 what I believe were heel drag marks in the dirt leading
9 from the wash to the bush indicating to me that whoever
14:07:15 10 had dumped her had pulled her up out by the arms and the
11 chest then was dragging the feet behind.

12 Q Is this body ultimately sealed up in a bag
13 and taken to the coroner's office for an autopsy?

14 A Yes.

14:07:33 15 Q Did you attend that autopsy?

16 A Yes, I did.

17 Q I want to first show you State's 49. What
18 are we looking at here?

19 A That's a cleaned-up photo of the front of
14:07:52 20 the body and the underwear that are on inappropriate.
21 You can see on the upper leg the frilly part is supposed
22 to be the top part of the underwear and then the thinner
23 part that goes through the crotch is actually going
24 around the right leg of the body.

14:08:12 25 Q Understood. Did you witness personally the

14:08:15 1 autopsy?

2 A Yes, I did.

3 Q Was there any indication of external
4 injuries to Miss Palacio's body?

14:08:25 5 A Due to the state of decomposition there was
6 no obvious trauma on the body.

7 Q And the coroner would have conducted an
8 internal examination as well?

9 A Correct.

14:08:38 10 Q To your knowledge, was there any indication
11 of internal trauma that was observed, well, by yourself
12 or by the medical examiner?

13 A No, there was nothing of note internally.

14 Q As of right now as we sit here today, is
14:08:52 15 the cause and manner of death by the coroner's office
16 still pending?

17 A Yes, they're waiting for toxicology
18 reports.

19 Q Okay. After the autopsy was conducted, did
14:09:04 20 you ultimately learn that one of the two Rangels was
21 taken into custody?

22 A Yes.

23 Q Were you present for that?

24 A No.

7 homicide investigation regarding Lesly Palacio?

8 A Yes, I was.

9 Q Did you work on that case alongside
14:12:46 10 Detective Gary King?

11 A Yes, I did.

12 Q And I kind of want to skip forward because
13 we talked about the investigation. Did you ultimately
14 learn that Jose Rangel had been arrested?

14:12:55 15 A Yes, I did.

16 Q And was that in February of this year?

17 A That's correct.

18 Q Where was he arrested to your knowledge?

19 A He was arrested in the San Ysidro border
14:13:04 20 patrol station and then ultimately extradited and
21 brought to Clark County Detention Center.

22 Q Okay. To be fair to Mr. Jose Rangel, did
23 you get some indication that he actually turned himself
24 in at that location?

14:13:18 25 A I did, yes.

14:13:19 1 Q And did he also waive extradition meaning
2 he was transported back to Las Vegas willingly?

3 A Yes.

14:13:30 4 Q After that was done did you make contact
5 with him at Clark County Detention Center?

6 A I did.

7 Q And when you made contact with him did you
8 read him his Miranda rights?

9 A I did.

14:13:37 10 Q Did he waive those rights and agree to
11 speak with you?

12 A He did.

13 Q Did you question him regarding the
14 disappearance or murder of Lesly Palacio?

14:13:44 15 A Yes, I did.

16 Q And what did he say to you initially?

14:14:00 17 A Initially his statement was that he'd
18 become aware of the case through media that he had seen
19 when he was down in Mexico, and upon learning that he
20 was wanted in connection with that investigation he
21 decided to turn himself in. And then from there the
22 interview turned into what he recalled from the day of
23 the incident.

14:14:14 24 Q Okay. When he described what he recalled
25 from the day of the incident, did he acknowledge to you

14:14:18 1 that he knew Lesly Palacio and her family for several
2 years?

3 A He did.

14:14:27 4 Q Did he describe to you what happened the
5 morning she went missing?

6 A His initial statement was, to put it
7 lightly, watered down to reduce his involvement
8 initially. And then as the interview progressed he
9 decided to be forthcoming from what he did recall.

14:14:43 10 Q Okay. Let me ask you, in his initial
11 version did he essentially deny leaving the residence
12 with his son Erick on August 30th of 2020?

13 A He initially did, yes.

14:15:00 14 Q Did he say essentially that all he
15 remembered was it seemed like the girl had an overdose
16 and Erick had -- well, that?

17 A Yes, that's correct.

18 Q Okay. Did you at some point confront him
19 with the video surveillance from the Tipper Street?

14:15:16 20 A I did, yes.

21 Q At that point in time did he provide a
22 different version of events?

14:15:25 23 A He did. He then stated that he wanted to
24 be completely open and honest with us from that point on
25 and then acknowledged his involvement from that point.

14:15:28

1 Q What did he say was his involvement after
2 he had learned of the surveillance video?

14:15:39

3 A He stated that morning he was awake early
4 in the morning preparing to take his wife to church as
5 well as a job that he was going to have later that
6 afternoon. He would have been in the garage area and he
7 hears his son Erick come inside and he hears somebody
8 else is with him that he believed to be Lesly Palacio.

14:15:59

9 They go upstairs, they're gone for about 30
10 minutes, he continues to do some things in the garage
11 and then Erick comes down. Erick is shirtless and the
12 body of Lesly Palacio has been drug down on a sheet, a
13 bed sheet, and Erick is starting to freak out at that
14 point and states that he has to do something with the
15 body.

14:16:17

16 At that point Jose decided that he needed
17 to help him get the body out of the residence before
18 anyone else within the household, being his daughters or
19 his wife saw the body to eliminate their involvement,
20 and he did help him load the body at that point into
21 Erick's vehicle.

14:16:30

22 Q Did Mr. Jose Rangel indicate to you whether
23 there was any blood or vomit or anything that he noticed
24 on the body?

14:16:47

25 A He stated that based on the way she was

14:16:50 1 lying on that sheet that she appeared to be deceased to
2 him but he did not see physical injuries to indicate
3 that. He did not recall seeing any vomit or any other
4 bodily discharge or any blood to him, but he did

14:17:06 5 describe the fact that she was only dressed in a shirt
6 and that her panties were pulled up awkwardly on her but
7 she was not wearing any pants.

8 Q Did you ask him was that you in the video
9 hosing off the driveway?

14:17:22 10 A I did. He identified himself in the video
11 initially loading her into the vehicle with Erick. He
12 identified himself closing the door of that vehicle
13 after the body was put in and then he did acknowledge
14 the fact that he was outside cleaning up or watering
14:17:38 15 down the driveway and moving some things around the
16 front of the house afterwards as well.

17 Q Did he claim, however, with regard to the
18 hosing the driveway off that he wasn't doing it to
19 destroy evidence, he was doing it for some other reason?

14:17:52 20 A He stated he was nervous and he didn't know
21 what to do with himself at that point so he stayed out
22 front. He gave a story that he had received a letter
23 from his HOA that their yard needed to be cleaned up and
24 he went in that mode since he was out front and that's
14:18:08 25 what he was doing.

14:18:10

1 Q Did you ask him whether he or his wife
2 cleaned up evidence inside the scene meaning inside the
3 home?

14:18:21

4 A I did ask him that. He denied having any
5 involvement with that. He did not believe his wife or
6 anybody else in the house had any part of a cleanup
7 inside the residence.

8 Q Did you ask him if he physically went to
9 Mexico with his son?

14:18:45

10 A I did. He stated that afternoon, well,
11 that morning Erick leaves with the body and Jose
12 believed he was going to Utah to destroy the body is
13 what he was told. He did not believe he would see Erick
14 return that day or did not know when he would be coming
15 back. So later that afternoon when he goes to his

14:19:04

16 daughter's apartment, Erick shows up. He sees Erick,
17 Erick is acting very weird, making some statements to
18 the fact that he may kill himself or he may kill Jose,
19 made some other statements that people may come kill
20 them or the family. Jose makes a decision to then leave
21 the area with Erick. They gather some money up and
22 drive to Southern California and then eventually into
23 Mexico.

14:19:28

24 Q And the place where Jose was apprehended,
25 is that a point where you could reenter the United

14:19:40

14:19:43 1 States from Mexico?

2 A That's correct.

3 Q Okay. Did Erick, I'm sorry, not Erick, did
4 Jose indicate to you that he and his son discussed what
14:19:54 5 happened on the way to Mexico?

6 A We asked about any conversations that they
7 may have made had related to the incident and what Jose
8 recalled was Erick would not get into details but he
9 made some statements to Jose along the lines that she
14:20:12 10 may have overdosed on narcotics and had drank a lot that
11 night.

12 Q Okay.

13 A But he doesn't have any specifics to
14 anything else other than that, at least that he was
14:20:22 15 willing to tell us.

16 Q Okay. Other than that version that Erick
17 gave to Jose, did he say anything about Erick saying how
18 Lesly ended up dead other than what you just described?

19 A No.

14:20:37 20 Q Okay. And ladies and gentlemen of the
21 Grand Jury, I'll just admonish you that statement in its
22 entirety is only to be used against Jose Rangel and not
23 to be used for any purpose whatsoever against Erick
24 Rangel. Does everyone understand that advisement and
14:20:53 25 promise and agree to follow that advisement? Everyone

14:20:55 1 is nodding their heads yes.

2 Thank you, sir. I have no further
3 questions.

14:21:01 4 THE FOREPERSON: By law these proceedings
5 are secret and you are prohibited from disclosing to

BY MR. GIORDANI:

Q How are you employed, sir?

4

A I'm currently employed as a detective with

the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department currently

assigned to the homicide section.

Q How long have you been in the homicide

8

section?

9

A Eight years.

14:22:55

10

Q And were you involved in an investigation

11

that started as a missing persons and turned into a

12

homicide investigation regarding Lesly Palacio?

13

A I was.

14

Q Did you have a particular role when it came

14:23:07

15

to the investigation?

16

A I did.

17

Q What was that role, sir?

18

A Typically in our investigations we do what

19

is known as a wolf pack approach. That means that we go

14:23:16

20

out as a squad and then everyone is given different duty

21

assignments. In this case it was a division of labor.

22

My job or my primary responsibility during that

23

investigation was to conduct a search along with crime

24

scene analysts of a residence down in the southeast part

14:23:33

25

of Las Vegas.

14:23:34 1 Q And was that residence located at 5285
2 Tipper Avenue?

3 A It was.

4 Q Is that here within Clark County, Nevada?

14:23:41 5 A It is.

6 Q And out in the hallway I believe I showed
7 you State's Proposed Exhibits 4 through 34.

8 A You did.

9 Q Do those all appear to be photographs of
14:23:53 10 the residence during the course of the execution of the
11 search warrant?

12 A Yes, they do.

13 Q And all fair and accurate depictions of how
14 it appeared on the day that you searched it?

14:24:02 15 A Correct.

16 Q And that date was?

17 A It was September 2nd, 2020.

18 Q I'm going to show you now State's 4. What
19 are we looking at generally?

14:24:17 20 A So this photo that you see before you is
21 the front of the residence. This is a two-story single
22 family residence, approximately 13 to 1400 square feet
23 and it's north facing. So this photograph, if we could
24 figure out the orientation, is looking from north to
14:24:35 25 south viewing the front of the residence.

14:24:38 1 Q Fair to say there's a black, I believe it's
2 a Cadillac sitting in the driveway?

3 A There is.

14:24:45 4 Q Showing you State's 5, what are we looking
5 at here?

6 A So this photo is inside that single
7 carport, if you will, to the garage area looking from
8 the south towards the north. In fact, that silver/gray
9 van is my vehicle, my Metro vehicle.

14:25:00 10 Q And I believe that might be your face.

11 A That might very well be my head.

12 Q State's 6, what are we looking at here?

13 A So going to the aforementioned black, it's
14 a 2004 Cadillac, it looks like an SUV, this is under the
14:25:16 15 front end of the vehicle. This is the left front wheel
16 that you see to the right of that photo and underneath
17 it is a maroon rug consistent with like a bath rug.

18 Q State's 7, now what are we looking at here?

14:25:31 19 A So we're again looking from the south, from
20 the north to the south. This would be the west side of
21 that residence. And as you can tell there's not much
22 space between the adjacent homes in this particular
23 neighborhood.

14:25:47 24 Q Fair to say there's at least one, maybe
25 three trash cans on the side of the residence?

14:25:49

1 A Correct.

2 Q State's 8, what are we looking at here?

3 A So this photograph is one of those two or
4 three trash cans looking down into the trash can at what
5 appears to be like a garment or a blanket of some sort.

14:26:02

6 Q Now I'm moving into the home at State's 9,
7 what are we looking at here?

8 A So this photograph is inside the residence
9 on the first floor inside what would be known as the
10 living room looking at a couch within the living room.

14:26:17

11 Q On the couch what are we looking at there?

12 A So kind of in the lower left-hand corner is
13 a pair of blue latex-like gloves.

14 Q And State's 10, is that a close-up of the
15 gloves?

14:26:34

16 A It is.

17 Q Were those ultimately impounded by crime
18 scene analysts for further testing?

19 A They were.

14:26:41

20 Q State's 11, what are we looking at here?

21 A Now we're again on the first floor of the
22 residence. If we could rotate 180 degrees from this
23 particular photograph, the living room would be directly
24 behind us. In this case we are looking from south to

14:26:56

25 north at the kitchen. If you look in the center of that

14:26:59 1 photograph where the blinds are pulled down, looking out
2 that window you would have seen that window depicted in
3 the first photograph of the front of the residence.

4 Q And what's on the floor of the kitchen
14:27:10 5 area?

6 A So in those white trash bags, those
7 commonly known as like a kitchen trash bag, what
8 appeared to be an effort to move out the contents of the
9 residence, and instead of using your traditional boxes
14:27:23 10 the group that was moving utilized these bags.

11 Q Fair to say there are also cleaning
12 supplies up on the counter?

13 A Yes.

14 Q State's 12?

14:27:33 15 A So specifically like in that last
16 photograph to the left, and now this is a close-up
17 photo, are cleaning supplies.

18 Q What are we looking at in State's 13?

19 A So going back to two photographs ago of the
14:27:45 20 kitchen, this was on the right-hand side in the corner
21 near the sink is a mop bucket and a mop.

22 Q On the head of that mop does there appear
23 to be a dark substance on the bottom right portion of
24 the exhibit?

14:28:02 25 A Yes, there is.

14:28:02 1 Q Was that mop impounded for further testing?
2 A Yes.

3 Q State's 14, what are we looking at here?
4 A So now we're transitioning back into the
14:28:21 5 living room. This would be the living room slash dining
6 room, if you will. That would be I guess most commonly
7 known as a dining room table and there's a variety of
8 items that are on that particular table.

9 Q These items down here on the left-hand
14:28:36 10 corner of the table, what does that appear to be?
11 A So again that is another pair of latex-like
12 blue gloves.

13 Q State's 15 proceeding upstairs I presume?
14 A Correct. So this particular photograph,
14:28:49 15 again the house faces north, so this -- if you're coming
16 up the stairs it's in a two-part thing with a landing in
17 between the two sets of stairs. So in this particular
18 photograph this is being taken from the landing looking
19 from north to south into that house on the second floor.

14:29:12 20 Q Were there three bedrooms on the second
21 floor?
22 A Correct.

23 Q Showing you State's 16, is this one of
24 those bedrooms?
14:29:19 25 A It is.

14:29:23

1 Q Well, if you can orient the jury, is this
2 up the stairs and to the right?

3 A Yes. So if we had continued up that last
4 set of stairs we would be on the second floor.

14:29:31

5 Immediately turning to our right is the door. In fact
6 where you see his right thumb, that would be, we would
7 be hooking that corner to go into, this is like would be
8 commonly associated as the north bedroom because it's on
9 the north side of the house.

14:29:49

10 Q Showing you State's 17, is this a bed
11 within the north bedroom?

12 A It is.

13 Q Does there appear to be any sheets on that
14 bed?

14:29:55

15 A So it appeared that the fitted sheet
16 typically that would go over a mattress was gone.

17 Q And State's 18, is this that same bed we
18 were just looking at?

19 A Just a little bit closer to the edge of the
20 mattress.

14:30:09

21 Q And I want to zoom in a little bit here.
22 What are we looking at here between the white and the
23 green towels or blankets?

24 A So that little stain or apparent stain

14:30:22

25 that's almost centrally located in that particular

14:30:25 1 photograph wound up being a spot of apparent, apparent
2 blood.

3 Q State's 19, is this that same bedroom?

4 A Yes, it is.

14:30:38 5 Q Does there appear to be a white-collared
6 shirt hanging in the left-hand side of this exhibit?

7 A There is.

8 Q Outside of the closet but on essentially a
9 free-standing rack?

14:30:49 10 A On a rack. There was like two or three
11 other buttoned-up shirts that were on that same rack.

12 Q Showing you State's 20, is this that same
13 bedroom?

14:30:59 14 A It is. And this would be looking down on
15 the ground and just inside the entryway of that
16 particular bedroom. As you can see on the upper
17 right-hand corner is the door.

18 Q And what is this red card here?

14:31:11 19 A It appeared to be a gaming card associated
20 with one of the local gaming establishments here in Las
21 Vegas.

22 Q And whose name was on that card?

23 A Erick, E-R-I-C-K, Rangel.

14:31:23 24 Q Showing you State's 21, we're still in the
25 same room, correct?

14:31:24 1 A We are.

2 Q And we can see from this prospective that
3 white shirt you referenced earlier?

4 A Yes. So on the right-hand side of that
14:31:31 5 bedroom is that rack and that is the northern most
6 garment hanging on that rack.

7 Q And State's 22, what are we looking at
8 here?

9 A So on that garment, if you can see the
14:31:42 10 patterns you can see sort of like a blue fragmented
11 pattern is another stain of apparent blood.

12 Q And you say apparent. Is there a reason
13 you say apparent blood?

14 A Because I don't want to tell you that
14:31:56 15 that's blood and then it be shown otherwise, so
16 apparent.

17 Q Is there something called a phenolphthalein
18 test or something to that effect?

19 A Phenolphthalein?

14:32:04 20 Q Phenolphthalein test that crime scene
21 analysts do on scene?

22 A Correct. It's a presumptive test to
23 identify the presence of blood.

24 Q And that's in no way definitive that it is
14:32:16 25 blood; would that be a fair assumption?

14:32:19 1 A Well, there's different kinds of blood.
2 You could actually have canine blood, you can have human
3 blood, so it might identify as blood but understand that
4 it may not be human blood.

14:32:29 5 Q Understood. But the items that did show
6 positive presumptive for blood, those items were
7 impounded from the residence?

8 A A swab of those stains, yes, a
9 representative swab of those stains.

14:32:41 10 Q To include this here on the white shirt?

11 A Indeed.

12 Q State's 23, is this the same bedroom but
13 now the blankets have been removed from the mattress?

14 A Correct.

14:32:52 15 Q And State's 24, is that another or I guess
16 that same spot of apparent blood?

17 A Just another photograph now with the marker
18 that the crime scene analyst would apply showing that
19 they had swabbed that stain and identified it as an
14:33:07 20 apparent bloodstain.

21 Q And there appears to be a wallet in the top
22 left corner; is that correct?

23 A There is.

24 Q And was that opened up?

14:33:15 25 A It was.

14:33:15 1 Q State's 25, what are we looking at here?

2 A So this is the contents of the wallet that
3 was depicted in the previous photo.

4 Q And fair to say there's several
14:33:24 5 identifications in the name of Erick Rangel-Ibarra?

6 A Fair, yes.

7 Q The subject of today's Indictment?

8 A Correct.

9 Q And for the record I am going to use the
14:33:35 10 Wite-Out and get rid of the social security number. I
11 did not realize that was in there, I apologize. State's
12 26, is this now a different bedroom?

13 A It is.

14 Q State's 27, what are we looking at here?

14:33:57 15 A So primarily depicted in the middle of that
16 photograph is a roll of what would again common kitchen
17 trash bags. Going back to some of the earlier photos,
18 it appeared that the occupants of the home were
19 employing those bags to use as a means to pull items out
14:34:17 20 of the house.

21 Q State's 28, what is this on the bed here,
22 if you know?

23 A I can't see the -- it appears to be a
24 bottle of some sort but I might be wrong.

14:34:31 25 Q Okay. State's 29, what are we looking at

14:34:34 1 here?

2 A So in that same bedroom, this is looking to
3 the left, there's a little like vanity table or a table
4 for what looks like it could be used for a variety of
14:34:42 5 reasons, a desk and on that desk were apparent cleaning
6 supplies.

7 Q State's 30, is that just a close-up of one
8 of those cleaning supplies on the desk?

9 A Just a close-up of a bottle of ammonia.

14:35:04 10 Q With the lid off?

11 A The lid is off.

12 Q And what's that on the table next to the
13 ammonia?

14 A Those would be fake eyelashes.

14:35:13 15 Q State's 31, is this that same bedroom but
16 now it's been changed a little bit here?

17 A It has. And an explanation for why it's
18 been changed is that when we are conducting a search we
19 document the room with the photographs to see how we
14:35:26 20 found it. And then what we do is we move all of the
21 items that we're searching, whether it's in a dresser or
22 on a desk, to kind of a centralized location and in this
23 particular situation we utilized the bed. It's a big
24 area that we can place items and then that's how you see
14:35:43 25 so many more items on the bed when in the previous

14:35:46 1 photographs you don't have that depiction.

2 Q And State's 32, is that just various mail
3 and identification of Erick Rangel-Ibarra?

4 A And various documents, correct.

14:35:57 5 Q State's 33, what are we looking at here
6 generally?

7 A That is the bathroom, the master bathroom.

8 Q And State's 34, what are we looking at
9 there?

14:36:08 10 A So these are two apparent bloodstains that
11 were just forward the toilet that's in the master
12 bathroom.

13 Q And were those like the apparent, other
14 apparent bloodstains swabbed and then impounded as
14:36:23 15 evidence?

16 A They were.

17 MR. GIORDANI: I have no further questions
18 for this witness. Do any of the Grand Jurors have
19 questions?

14:36:28 20 Sir?

21 BY A JUROR:

22 Q I actually have a lot of questions but I'll
23 boil it down. When will the blood work be back?

24 A I would be speculating on that answer.

14:36:44 25 Q Okay. And then also as to the pending

14:36:47 1 autopsy results.

2 A That question would be best suited for the
3 medical examiner. There's unfortunately a backlog as
4 you might imagine these days with the COVID, especially
14:37:00 5 as it relates to toxicology findings, but again that is
6 not a question that I can answer probably accurately.

7 Q Okay. That's good. Thanks.

8 MR. GIORDANI: No follow-up?

9 A JUROR: No.

14:37:16 10 MR. GIORDANI: Anyone else have questions?

11 BY A JUROR:

12 Q Do the gloves follow under toxicology as
13 well?

14 A No. So referring to the Clark County
14:37:24 15 Coroner's office, they are a separate agency from the
16 LVMPD. Their toxicology testing is done through a
17 different lab. Metro has its own in-house laboratory,
18 although they may utilize other labs. I wouldn't be
19 able to tell you specifically when and where and what
14:37:44 20 situations they were, but in the case where the gloves,
21 for instance just as an example, those gloves are
22 examined before the forensic scientist and then those
23 swabs are taken off of the gloves and then put through
24 some kind of an analysis then we would get the results
14:38:01 25 of that analysis, but that is done within the Las Vegas

14:38:05 1 Metropolitan Police Department laboratory.

2 Q Did those results come back?

3 A I'm unaware of any results back on any of
4 the physical evidence that was collected pursuant to
14:38:13 5 this search warrant at the Tipper address.

6 MR. GIORDANI: Any further follow-up?
7 Seeing no hands.

8 THE FOREPERSON: By law these proceedings
9 are secret and you are prohibited from disclosing to
14:38:21 10 anyone anything that transpired before us including any
11 evidence presented to the Grand Jury, any event
12 occurring or a statement made in the presence of the
